

## Lower Drayton Farm Camping T&C's

Before booking camping with us we would like to make you aware of the following Terms and Conditions (T&C's)

- All guests to Lower Drayton Farm must adhere to all terms and conditions of Play@ in addition to the following camping terms.
- No refunds will be available once your booking has been made.
- Entry to Play@ Lower Drayton Farm is at an additional discounted cost, bookings must be made online before visiting the site.
- Booking changes must be made no later than five working days before your arrival date.
- Camping tickets are available from 21<sup>st</sup> July until the 31<sup>st</sup> Sept 2021, any changes to the booking must be made within this period. No bookings or changes can be made after the event end date.
- Booking availability will be indicated on the website [lowerdraytonfarm.co.uk](http://lowerdraytonfarm.co.uk) if you require a pitch at short notice please email us directly on [camp@lowerdraytonfarm.co.uk](mailto:camp@lowerdraytonfarm.co.uk) so we can check capacities and availability.
- Confirmation of your bookings will be sent by Digitickets on receipt of your order.
- Bookings must be made following the current government guidelines.
- Only persons on the booking are allowed to enter the campsite, no visitors allowed
- Up to 6 people only are allowed per pitch.
- Children under the age of 16 must be supervised at all times.
- Each pitch is clearly marked out, please ensure that you pitch correctly, you will be asked to move if your tent is not on the correct pitch or out of the guidelines.
- Pitches must be 10m apart, only one tent per pitch.
- Parents/ guardians are responsible for the behaviour of their children at all times.
- Open fires and fire pits are strictly forbidden, BBQ must only be used in the allocated BBQ area.
- Never place a BBQ in a tent, even when cooling. Fire extinguishers are provided on the campsite and are clearly indicated on the site map.
- No dogs allowed.
- Vehicles are to be parked on the campsite car park and not next to tents.
- All rubbish must be placed into the bins provided (only household and food waste to be disposed of in the site bins)
- No alcohol will be sold onsite, you must be over 18 to consume alcohol on the premises and you are welcome to bring your own.
- Fireworks are not permitted.

- Lower Drayton Farm will not be held responsible for any loss, damages. All visitors are responsible for their own property.
- Any deliberate damage made by an individual or group will result in the entire party being asked to leave the site immediately and local authorities maybe informed depending on the situation.
- First Aid equipment will be available and located at the Playbarn.
- Any assistance required after hours then you can contact the duty supervisor.
